

INDIGENOUS SOLUTIONS ACHIEVEMENTS

2018 saw many new beginings for Indigenous Solutions, including: fundraising online as well as a fundraising event. We produced two festivals; one on the Navajo Nation in Chinle, Arizona and the other at the Institute of American Indian Arts (IAIA) in Santa Fe, New Mexcio.

We closed the year receiving over \$13,000 in donations.

We continued with the fourth annual concert series hosting five artists who traveled from overseas (2) and out-of state (3), including: three indigenous singer/songwriters, and one LGBTQAI2 artist.

Five events included ASL intepreters.

The Aged Care Music Program saw four visits to Winslow, Arizona, bringing music to the Hopi and Navajo elders.

We catered to over 400 attendees and had over 80 volunteers.


